Voting analysis: Third Committee resolution on the situation of human rights in Syria

Overview

The vote was 122 for, 13 against with 41 abstaining. 17 States were absent.

Syria called a no action motion before the vote. The vote for the no action motion was 118 against, 20 for and 29 abstained. Nicaragua and Venezuela spoke in favour of the no action motion on principle against country specific resolutions. Saudi Arabia and France spoke against the motion drawing attention to the fact that the resolution is a circumstantial and unique initiative. Saudi Arabia noted that the situation in Syria cannot be ignored and that previous appeals have not been met with an appropriate response. The delegate reminded the Third Committee that the resolution should be seen as a one off situation.

Comparing votes to <u>Human Rights Council Resolution S-16/1</u> on Syria, Gabon and Mauritania switched their vote from **NO to YES**, and Nigeria, Saudi Arabia and Ukraine changed their vote from **Abstain to YES**. Bangladesh, China, Malaysia, Pakistan and the Russian Federation all changed their votes from **NO to Abstain**. Unfortunately Ghana and Zambia changed their votes from **YES to Abstain**.

Comparing votes to <u>Human Rights Council Resolution S-17/1</u>, Mauritania changed their vote from **Abstain to YES**, Congo and Thailand switched from **YES to Abstain**, while the Russian Federation and China changed their vote from **NO to Abstain**.

Apart from the United Kingdom (the main sponsor) and Syria, 19 States addressed the Third Committee. Iran, Venezuela, Cuba (on behalf of NAM), DPRK, Vietnam and Ecuador (who all voted **NO**) spoke strongly against the resolution on principle against state resolutions. Singapore and Thailand also spoke against country resolutions but **abstained**. Malaysia, the Russian Federation and China (who also **abstained**) emphasised an increased focus on mutual dialogue and cooperation.

Costa Rica (who voted in favour of the resolution) stated that country specific resolutions should be used to look at grave human rights violations and that the international community cannot deviate from its responsibility to address such violations. Israel and the Ukraine also spoke in favour of the resolution.

Besides Syria, Saudi Arabia and Egypt were the only two Arab States to address the Third Committee, both of whom voted in favour of the resolution. Egypt noted that the resolution improved over the last few days, and became more consistent with the approach taken by the Arab League. Egypt welcomed the call to immediately implement the Arab League's plan of action. The delegate from Egypt also highlighted that the resolution ensures the preservation of Syrian unity, and cannot be interpreted as an invitation for foreign intervention.

<u>Of the states that traditionally oppose state resolution:</u> 9 states (Belarus, Cuba, DPRK, Iran, Syria, Uzbekistan, Venezuela, Vietnam, Zimbabwe) maintained that position but 4 states (Algeria, China, Russia, Malaysia) **Abstained** and 5 states (Oman, Libya, Egypt, Sudan, Kyrgyzstan) voted **YES**.

Votes by regional or other groups

Of the 56 OIC states: A majority (33) voted **YES**, 3 voted **NO** (Uzbekistan, Syria and Iran) **and** 14 **abstained**. 6 were absent.

Of the 117 states in the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM): Almost half (56) voted **YES** despite a principled NAM position against country resolutions in the General Assembly. A further 13 voted **NO** and 36 states **abstained**. 12 were **absent**.

<u>The majority of GRULAC states</u> supported the resolution with 21 states voting **YES**. Five States **abstained** (Antigua and Barbuda, Dominican Republic, Grenada, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines) and the usual 5 GRULAC states voted **NO** (Bolivia, Cuba, Ecuador, Nicaragua and Venezuela). Two were absent (Dominica and Suriname).

In the African group, over half of the present States voted **YES** (26) while Zimbabwe was the only State to vote **NO.** 16 States **Abstained** (Algeria, Angola, Cameroon, Comoros, Congo, Ghana, Kenya, Lesotho, Mali, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa, Swaziland, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, and Zambia). Eleven States were absent (Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Gambia, Niger, Sao Tome and Principe, Seychelles, Somalia and South Sudan).
